PingThemAll (PTA) files and what they do:

When you download PTA, you get a single ZIP file that contains everything you need. While PTA is running, other files and created and modified as needed for proper operation of the program.

Once your files are extracted, here's what you will see...

config.ini	PTA configuration file (you modify this file to change options.)	
pingthemall.exe	This is the PingThemAll program, called the <i>engine</i> .	
pingthese.txt	Edit this file to tell PTA what you want to monitor.	
readme.txt	Legal mumbo jumbo.	
data <i>folder</i>	Folder with data generated by PTA. This is how PTA keeps track of status changes.	
logs folder	Folder with logs generated by PTA. See Support Document PTA008.	
ptaresults <i>folder</i>	Folder with components of the PTA Results webpage.	

Inside the ptaresults folder, you will see...

header.html	Code for top of PTA Results page (gets regenerated as PTA runs.)	
logo.jpg	The upper left logo on the PTA Results page (you can change this.)	
logo.htm	Controls how logo.jpg is displayed.	
main.htm	Code for main part of PTA Results page (gets regenerated as PTA runs.)	
pingbad.jpg	Graphic when a ping fails (you can change this.)	
pinggood.jpg	Graphic when pings succeed (you can change, too.)	
ptapage.htm	This is what you run to see the PTA Results webpage.	
txtstyle.css	Code that affects how the results page looks.	

You will also see the following graphic files. We included these to give some options on what graphic you see on the PTA Results page when things are good or bad. To activate any of these, rename the existing pingbad.jpg or pinggood.jpg file, and then either copy or rename the desired graphic to pingbad.jpg or pinggood.jpg. (You can also create your own graphics)

pingbad-exclamation.jpg	Red exclamation point.
pingbad-thumb.jpg	Red thumb-down.
pinggood-happyface.jpg	Detailed happy face w/thumb up.
pinggood-thumb.jpg	Green thumb-up.
pinggood-yellowsmiley.jpg	Yellow smiley face.
